“Only 96 cases made from 1996 plantings of the D3V14 clone, taken from Pierro (with permission I’d expect). Plum and chocolate - very ripe with just a touch of the regional eucalypt coming through. It’s medium to full bodied, slightly warmish, but full of flavour with some olive-licious savoury accents. Toothsome tannin that’s grainy but fine and a long nutty finish. Delicious.
