“This Chardonnay comes from the cooler Southern area of the Margaret River. It has been given the works by the winemaking team at Higher Plane and the end product reflects this. Classy and elegant in structure with neat white nectarine, citrus lemons along with cashew oak. Lean and stylish in palate delivery, the fruit melds well with the nutty oak, a touch of marble character and an accompanying fresh lively acidity.

The flavours are delicious, long and lightly creamy on the finish.
